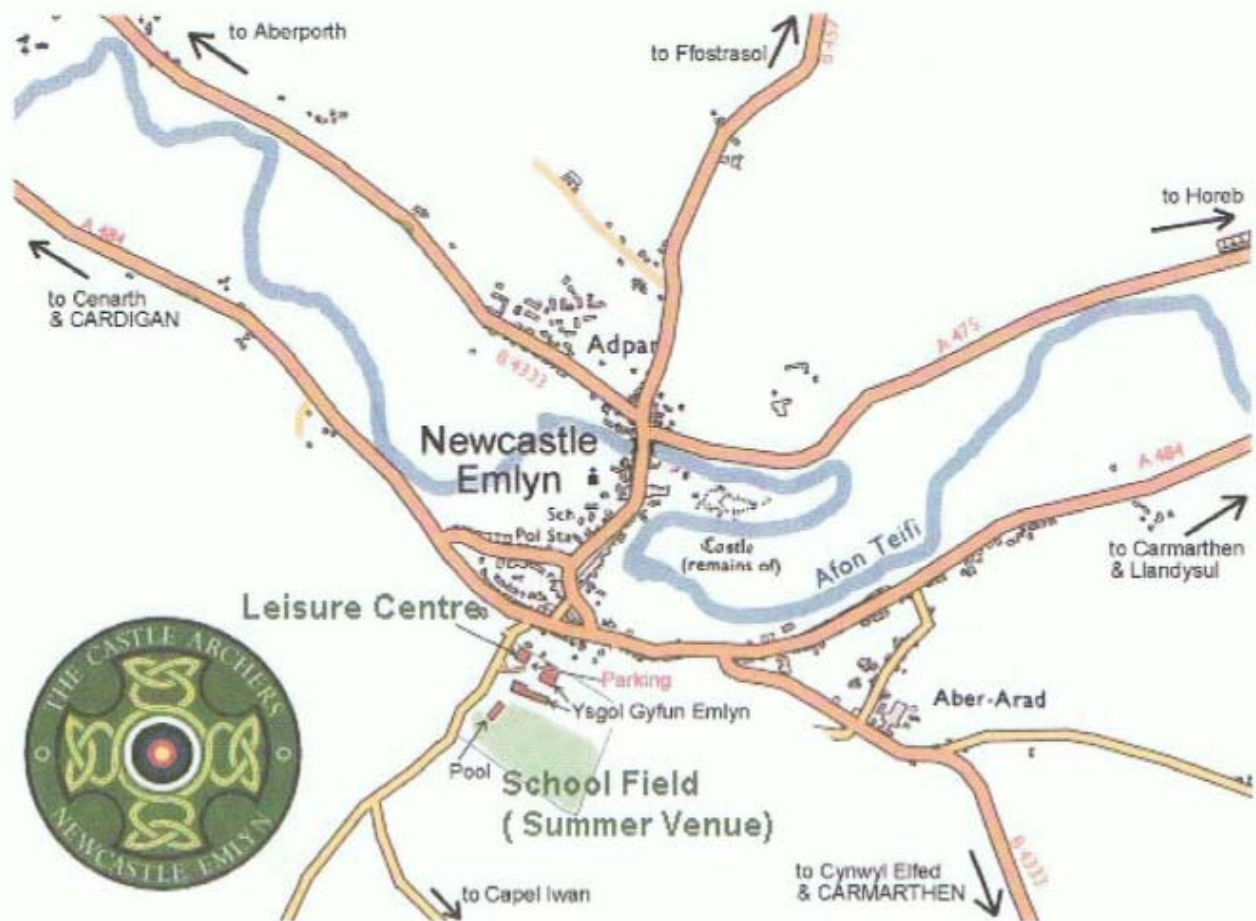
All entrants must be members of the GNAS and must abide by the GNAS dress code. Registered club colours may be worn in place of GNAS colours.

Directions: From Carmarthen, take the A484 to Newcastle Emlyn and turn left up the hill, following the brown sign to the leisure centre. From Cardigan, arrive on the A484 and turn right up the hill. From Lampeter, take the A475, turn left over the bridge in Newcastle Emlyn, go through the town and follow signs to Carmarthen, then turn right, then left up the hill. From Aberystwyth, take the A487 to Synod Inn, then the A486 to Ffostrasol, then the B4571 to Newcastle Emlyn to arrive at the bridge.

The venue is suitable for disabled archers, but if you have special requirements please inform the organisers beforehand.
