## THE PEMBROKE COMPANY OF ARCHERS HEREFORD INVITATION SHOOT

Another excellent Hereford entry for our Invitation shoot! County archers from seven clubs were present.

Unfortunately this meant that we were unable to offer any Junior Bristol Rounds again this year.

Apologies to those juniors who sent an entry, fees will of course be refunded.

Ladies and Gents shot in the four recognised GNAS tournament bow styles of Recurve, Barebow, Longbow and Compound Unlimited. Late cancellations meant that that the field was not quite full.

Dave Hall, our club chairman, officiated, supported at the target, by Club Field Captain, Dave Cochlin.

Excellent weather on our sheltered field offered no excuse for wayward arrows, of no concern to most as some exceptional scores were recorded! The standard of score keeping was much better, just one or two small addition errors to correct in the final result.

- Jon Thornhill returned to form this year to win the Gents Trophy with a recurve score of 1050.
- Mal Williams took the Gents Barebow Medal with a score of 835, (just missing out on Rick Pike's recently claimed County Record of 839)
- Jeremy Phillips won the Compound Gold Medal with a score of 1264, the highest score recorded at the club field. Andrew Watts and Warren Codd also recorded scores of 1234 and 1224 respectively.
- Stuart Edwards donated a longbow trophy to the club and duly won it with a score of 482! - exceeding his own county record of 386 and the existing Welsh Record of 405 (May 2000).
- Victoria Kalmaru stole the show with a barebow score of 915, exceeding both Lady and Gent Dyfed County Records and the existing Welsh Record scores for the round (Lady 853, Gent 890). The Ladies Recurve Trophy was awarded on this occasion in recognition of the achievement.

There were no Lady Recurve, Compound or Longbow entries this year, significant of the numbers shooting in the county – the county must have a concerted recruitment campaign!

The efforts of the club members in field preparation before the day and work at the shoot were greatly appreciated. Thanks to Gordon and Robyn, (aided by Nathan), for collecting scores and keeping the leader board and to all who donated raffle prizes. Robyn again charmed most of us present into purchasing more tickets than intended – or maybe it was the chance of winning that turned “milking stool” beautifully made by Gordon!

Finally thanks to all who attended and helped make an enjoyable shoot for everyone, we look forward to seeing you all again next year, bring a friend, preferably a Lady, shooting Recurve!
