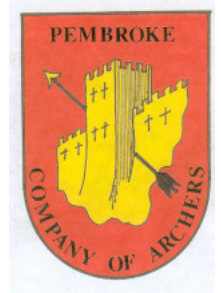




The Pembroke Company of Archers



SUNDAY CLUB TARGET DAY STARTING TIMES

(As agreed at the 2007 Club Annual General Meeting held on 13th May 2007)

The arrival and round starting times for the main Sunday Target Day are as follows: -

10.30 am for 11.00 am sighters

11.30am for 12.00 noon sighters

1.00 pm for 2.00 pm sighters

(Lunch 1.30 pm - 2.00pm)

No practice is permitted prior to sighters otherwise the round shot cannot be recorded.
(FITAMetric rounds are permitted practice at the first distance under the control of the Field Captain)

Members should arrive by the stated times to ensure that the field can be set up to suit those shooting

The main Sunday start time remains as 2.00 pm, the earlier starts are intended to accommodate those archers wishing to shoot longer rounds or who have other commitments on a particular afternoon.

It is hoped that most club members will be able to shoot throughout the afternoon and maintain the camaraderie and social interaction established over the years.

All shooting must be under the control of the Field or Vice Captain

In the absence of either Captain, a club officer or an established senior archer must assume the control of the field before any shooting can commence. Rules of Shooting and Archers Etiquette must be observed at all times.

Targets should be set up in consideration of the later start times and the numbers starting in the afternoon. Setting up and clearing away of targets should be under the direction of the Field Captain, in due consideration of shooting in progress.

Subject to target space, any member may "practice" but must do so on the understanding that round shooting must not be disrupted in any way. Any archer practicing will be required to relinquish their space and give priority to archers arriving for a later start time if necessary.

PLEASE DO NOT CAUSE UNDUE DISRUPTION SHOULD YOU ARRIVE OR LEAVE WHILST SHOOTING IS IN PROGRESS
